INSTRUCTION SHEET TO BE KEPT WITH PERMIT.

This permit represents a contract between you and the State of Washington wherein it is stipulated that you begin and complete the construction of whatever works are necessary to facilitate your diversion of the water for the purposes set out in the permit. Also, that this water be put to the full use as stated: All of these requirements to be fulfilled within a certain designated time. If you are not able to do so, you should notify this office and request an extension of time.

For an extension of time under beginning of construction there is a statutory extension fee of one-half of the permit fee. There are no fees for extensions on the completion of construction and complete application of water. As each step is completed, you should file the necessary forms in this office as set out in the Water Coas.

If the property under which your permit has been issued is sold, an assignment of the water right permit should be made. The Water Code states that "any permit or portion of a right under a permit may be assigned but no such assignment shall be valid nor binding unless recorded in the office of the Supervisor of Hydraulics." There is a \$2.00 statutory fee for recording assignments. An assignment form will be sent to you upon request by this office.

If it is desired to change the point of diversion, the place of use or the use of the water, a petition of change must be filed with the Supervisor of Hydraulics.

As soon as the Notices of Completion of Construction, Complete Application of Water to a Beneficial Use and Proof of Appropriation are filed, with the payment of the statutory fees of \$1.40 payable to the Department of Conservation and Development and 75¢ made out to the County Auditor a final water right certificate will be issued to you. This certificate is appurtenant to the land and therefore is the right of the owner of the land.

As stated, the above steps are necessary in the process of acquiring the final water right. If, after due notices by this office, you do not fulfill these requirements, the permit may be cancelled at the discretion of the Supervisor of Hydraulics. After such cancellation, any use of the water will be termed a misdemeanor and as such is punishable by law.

We shall be glad to assist you with any problems which arise in connection with your water rights.

Since June 15, 1917, the date our State Water Code went into effect, it has been necessary, in order to legally appropriate and use water, to make application and obtain permit from the Supervisor of Hydraulics. The water Code provides that "Any person, municipal corporation, firm, irrigation district, association, corporation or water users' association hereafter desiring to appropriate water for beneficial use shall make an application to the State Supervisor of Hydraulics for a permit to make such appropriation."

However, if water was appropriated and used before June 15, 1917, and continuously used thereafter, the right has become vested for the quantity of water and purposes for which it was actually used and it is not necessary to obtain a permit from this office for its use. All permits are issued subject to existing water rights.

We are enclosing a blank form for making application for permit, together with section plats. A \$5.00 examination fee is due at the time
application is filed. Instructions and schedule of other fees will be
found on the back of the application, however, the applicant will be
notified of such fees as they become due.

Notice, prepared by this office, will be sent to the applicant, who must have it published in two consecutive weekly issues of a newspaper of general circulation published at the county seat of the county or counties in which the diversion and use are to be made, and the cost of such publication must be paid by applicant.

A poriod of thirty days after date of final publication is allowed for filing protests, after which an examination is made on the ground by a representative of this effice. If he finds that there is water available and that the proposed use will not interfere with existing rights, permit will be granted. (Total cost, including publication, of obtaining a water right for individual household or domestic use and irrigation of up to twenty acres, usually amounts to about \$15.00.)

Permits for water rights carry no right-of-way privilege. If your pipe lines or other structures are not entirely on your own property, you must secure right-of-way from the owner of the property on which you propose to place them.
